Their vision is "to become and independent farmer-based organization, leading the supply of quality Organic Fairtrade cocoa beans whose members have improved livelihood and are resilient."

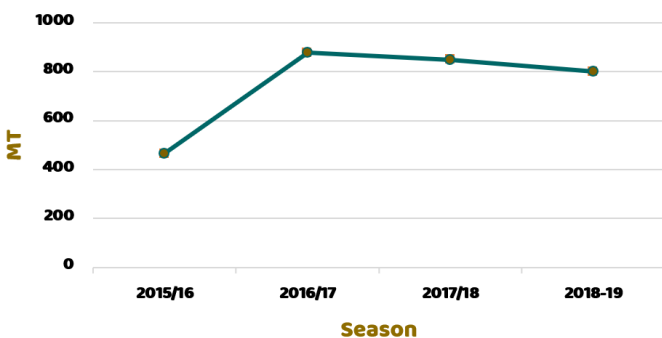

Progreso has been supporting ABOCFA since 2012 with organizational development and cocoa marketing. ABOCFA has increased their sales volume, their export sales and they obtained more premiums for their cocoa. The premiums have enhanced the financial situation of ABOCFA. Due to different trainings, ABOCFA's staff capacity has improved and they have been able to provide good services to their members in terms of training on good agricultural practices. However, in 2017 these trainings have reduced in frequency as the quality of cocoa had increased, so a slightly lower score in services is provided. In 2019, ABOCFA graduated from the support of Progreso as they have shown full potential to be independent and have obtained long term market relations with international buyers.
